Paniolo Day at Kahuku

Come join us for a full day celebrating the paniolo history of the Park's newest acquisition, the 116,000 acres formerly known as Kahuku Ranch.

The day will feature:

- Demonstrations of Paniolo skills - riding & roping
- Paniolo "Talk Story" sessions about the ranching days at Kahuku
- Self-guided walks into the upcountry ranchlands at Kahuku
- Park naturalists explaining the natural history of the area, pointing out its biological treasures, and describing the Parks' plan to transform pastures back into native forest.

Tim Richards, Kahuku Ranch Manager, and Supervisor of Kahuku's transition to Park lands, talking about innovations in 21st century ranching practices.

Laura Schuster, the Park's Cultural Resources Chief, describing the archeological and cultural sites still being discovered within Kahuku.

After a day of exploration, information, and adventure, guests gather at 4 P.M. for a **Chuckwagon Dinner and Music**

Enjoy BBQ beef, chicken, rice, potatoes, rolls, green salad, mac nut pie, soda, juice, and cowboy coffee while Bob Banks serenades us with sweet Hawaiian country music.

This day of celebration of Kahuku's Paniolo past is a fundraiser for Hawai`i Volcanoes National Parks' current commitment to upgrade interpretive signage throughout the Park.
